#### DISTRICT OF LANGFORD BYLAW NO. 177

#### A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF MUNICIPAL PARKS.

**WHEREAS** the Council has authority pursuant to Section 679 of the *Municipal Act*, to make rules and regulations regarding the management, maintenance, improvement, operation, conservation, control and use of property for pleasure, recreation or community uses of the public;

**WHEREAS** the Council has the possession and control of land and parks dedicated for the public by subdivision plan pursuant to Section 685 of the Municipal Act;

**WHEREAS** the municipality has authority to close all or part of property held in the municipality for pleasure and recreation at times and for periods considered advisable;

WHEREAS Council wishes to close municipal parks to public use thirty (30) minutes past sunset to thirty (30) minutes before sunrise;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

### "1. Definitions

- 1.1. "A" Class Park means a park wherein the intended use is a mix of active and passive recreation. "A" class parks may include play equipment and other buildings and structures intended for recreational purposes, and may encompass landscapes that are designed, planted and tended or left in a natural state. "A" class parks include, but are not strictly limited to neighbourhood parks, tot lots, and trails.
- 1.2. "C" Class Park means a park wherein the principal intended use is active recreation. "C" class parks are typically larger and more comprehensive parks including both indoor and outdoor recreation opportunities for the community at large. An example of a "C" class park is Langford's City Centre Park.
- 1.3. "E" Class Park means a park wherein the principal intended use is for the preservation of environmentally significant or aesthetically important natural features. As much as possible, and with the specific exception of the removal of invasive species, "E" class parksshall be left in a natural state, and not developed for active recreational opportunities.
- "Linear Park" means a Park whose characteristics typically allow for some form of connection between properties, places, or other transportation networks such as roads or rights-of-way. Linear parks may provide either pedestrian/bicycle access or a corridor for wildlife.
- **1.5.** Open Space means land that is in an undeveloped state that is owned by the City of Langford as a lot in fee simple.
- **1.6.** Park means land dedicated as park or used by the City as a park, sports field, playground, cemetery, trail, garden, or recreational area, and all buildings and improvements upon such

land.

- **1.7.** City means the City of Langford.
- **1.8.** Beach means all aquatic foreshores in the City of Langford.
- **1.9.** Sunrise the hour of the day for the rising of the sun as determined by Environment Canada.
- **1.10.** Sunset the hour of the day for the setting of the sun as determined by Environment Canada.
- **1.11.** Trail means a pedestrian or cycling route designed and maintained by the City of Langford on Park land, road right-of-way, or statutory right-of-way.
- **1.12.** Parks Manager means the person duly appointed by Council to serve as Parks Manager and any person acting lawfully under his or her authority.
- **1.13.** Bylaw Enforcement Officer means an individual appointed by Council as Municipal Bylaw Enforcement Officer, and can include a member of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police.
- **1.14.** Contractor means those individuals or companies hired by the City of Langford to carry out the maintenance and operational activities of City lands.
- **1.15.** Firearm includes a rifle, handgun or spring gun, crossbow, longbow, air pellet rifle, and any other weapon that releases a projectile.
- **1.16.** Fireworks includes cannon crackers, fireballs, firecrackers, mines, Roman Candles, sky rockets, squibs, torpedoes, and other explosive products or devices manufactured intentionally to produce an explosion, detonation, or pyrotechnic effect. This does not include caps for toy products, Christmas crackers, sparklers, or model rocket engines.
- **1.17.** Guide Dog means mobility Assistance Dogs for persons with disabilities, and Guide Dogs for persons with visual impairment.
- **1.18.** Leashed means affixed to a harness, tether, or locked extendable leash not exceeding 6 feet in length and held by a person.
- **1.19.** "Homeless Person" means a person who has neither a fixed address nor a predictable safe residence to return to on a daily basis.
- **1.20.** "Temporary Overnight Shelter" means a tent, lean-to, or other form of shelter that is temporary and portable in nature that is constructed from nylon, plastic, cardboard or other similar rigid or non-rigid material.
- **1.21. "Burning"** includes the combustion or heating of a substance to produce smoke, vapour, aerosol or other substances that can be inhaled.
- **1.22.** "Cannabis" has the same meaning as in the Cannabis Control and Licensing Act.
- **1.23.** "Smoke" means the act of burning a cigarette or cigar containing cannabis, tobacco or any other substance or burning or heating cannabis, tobacco or any other substance using a pipe, hookah pipe, lighted smoking device or vapourizing device and includes the following:

- (a) Holding lighted cannabis, tobacco or other substance;
- (b) Using or holding a device that is vapourizing cannabis, tobacco or other substance for inhalation or release into the air.
- **1.24. "Posted Notice"** means a sign or written notice of the Parks Manager which is affixed to any wall, post, fence, gate, tree, or notice board in any Park, Trail, or Beach.
- **1.25. "Controlled Substance" -** means a substance included in Schedule I, II, III, IV or V of the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act, S.C. 1996, c. 19.
- **1.26. "Drug Paraphernalia"** means any equipment that is used to store or consume a Controlled Substance.
- **1.27. "Public Place"** means any place, including privately owned land or leased property, to which the public reasonably has or is permitted to have access.

#### 2. Classification of Parks for Management and Operational Purposes

- **2.1.** For the purpose of park management, operation and use, municipal parks listed on "Schedule A" are hereby classified as either Class "A", Class "C" or Class "E" parks.
- **2.2.** Any land that is dedicated as park, but that is not listed on "Schedule A" is hereby classified as Class "E" park.

#### 3. Operating Hours

- **3.1.** All Class "A" and Class "C" parks listed on Schedule "A" are closed to public access between sunset and sunrise daily, unless otherwise specified in this bylaw or in an operating agreement pertaining to the park.
- **3.2.** All Class "E" parks listed on Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this bylaw are closed to public access, with the exception of those parts of a park occupied by a trail maintained by the City of Langford or unless otherwise specified in this bylaw or in an operating agreement pertaining to the park.
- **3.3.** Notwithstanding subsections 3.1 and 3.2 all parks listed on Schedule "A", attached to and forming part of this bylaw are hereby closed between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
- **3.4.** A Peace Officer of City employee may direct a person to leave any park for a set period of time if that person is acting in contravention of a City Bylaw.
- **3.5.** A person directed to leave a park must;
  - a) Immediately leave the land or premises; and
  - b) Not enter the land or premises again within the time period stipulated.
- **3.6.** If he or she deems it necessary to do so, the Parks Manager may close any Park, Trail, or Beach, or any area of a Park, Trail, or Beach, at any time and shall notify the public of the closure by affixing Posted Notices within the Park.

#### 4. Park Use

**4.1.** No person shall enter, use, occupy or remain in a municipal park contrary to Section 3 of this bylaw.

- **4.2.** No person other than an employee of the City acting in the course of his/her duties or a contractor authorized in writing by the Parks Manager, shall cut, break, injure, remove or in any way destroy or damage any tree shrub plant, turf, seat, bench, swing, playground equipment, sports equipment, or ornaments of any kind in any park, trail or on any beach.
- **4.3.** No person shall climb, walk, sit on any wall, fence, or other structure not intended for that purpose, or deface or destroy in any way any wall, fence, rock, tree or any other structure in or on any park, trail or beach.
- **4.4.** No person shall, whether or not with the use or aid of any animal, vehicle or other thing, perform or engage in any stunt or other activity within a park that is likely to distract, startle or interfere with other users of the park or cause damage to public or private property.
- **4.5.** No person shall, in a park, possess or consume liquor as defined in the Liquor Control and Licensing Act, except as is authorized under a Special Occasion Licence.
- **4.6.** The Parks Manager may affix Posted Notices in any Park, Trail, or Beach to notify the public of the regulations respecting the use of any Park, Trail, or Beach.
- **4.7.** No person shall deposit or dispose of any garbage in a park, trail, stream or lake or a receptacle in a park, or any garbage produced outside of the park.
- **4.8.** No person other than an employee or Contractor of the City acting in the course of his/her duties or a person authorized in writing by the Parks Manager shall remove any sand, soil, plants, tree, wood, log, or other matter from a park or excavate, dig, cut into or open up the natural terrain of any park, trail or beach.
- **4.9.** No person, without lawful excuse, other than a duly authorized officer acting in lawful capacity, without written permission from the Parks Manager, shall carry or discharge any firearm, use or explode any fireworks, or fire or explode any combustible or explosive material in any park, trail or beach.
- **4.10.** No person shall camp overnight in or on any portion of any park or beach.
- **4.11.** No person shall construct or place in or on any portion of any park, open space, beach or trail a temporary overnight shelter or temporary building without first obtaining a written permit issued by the Parks Manager.
- **4.12.** No person shall construct or place in or on any park, open space, trail or beach a shelter, pavilion or permanent structure without first obtaining the permission of Council.
- **4.13.** Despite subsection 4.10, subsection 4.11 and subsection 4.12 of this Bylaw, where there is no accessible overnight shelter accommodation available within the City or the vicinity thereof, a homeless person may erect and occupy a temporary overnight shelter in a park subject to the restrictions set out in subsection 4.14.
- **4.14.** A temporary overnight shelter permitted under subsection 4.13:
  - (a) must not be erected before 7:00 p.m. on any one day and must be taken down and removed before 7:00 a.m. on the next day following when Daylight Saving Time is not in effect;

- (b) must not be erected before 8:00 p.m. on any one day and must be taken down and removed before 7:00 a.m. on the next day following when Daylight Saving Time is in effect;
- (c) must not be erected or occupied at any time in, upon or within 10 metres of any of the following:
  - (i) washroom facilities;
  - (ii) a road, driveway or parking facilities;
  - (iii) a pathway, trail, bridge, boardwalk, dock or wharf;
  - (iv) a beach;
  - (v) land designated on the City's official community plan as development permit areas for the purpose of protecting the natural environment; and
- (d) must not be erected or occupied at any time in, upon or within 100 metres of any of the following:
  - (i) a playground, spray park or pool;
  - (ii) a horticultural display area or garden;
  - (iii) a tennis court or other sport court;
  - (iv) a sport field, stadium or dugout;
  - (v) a stage or bleachers;
  - (vi) a picnic shelter or gazebo;
  - (vii) recreation facilities;
  - (viii) a cenotaph; and
- (e) must not occupy more than 9 square meters in area, including all associated objects and possessions.
- **4.15.** Any temporary overnight shelter erected or maintained contrary to this bylaw may be removed under subsection 6.4.
- **4.16.** No person shall abandon, deposit, dispose of or leave unattended any chattel, refuse or other thing in any park, open space, trail, beach, or other public place other than the disposal of refuse in the appropriate receptacle.
- **4.17.** No person shall abandon, deposit, dispose of or leave needles or other drug paraphernalia in any park, open space, beach, trail, or other public place.
- **4.18.** No person shall light, ignite or maintain a fire on any park, trail, or beach without first obtaining a written permit issued by the Fire Chief for the City.
- **4.19.** No person shall sell or offer to sell refreshments, goods or services or conduct any business in any park, trail, or beach except with permission from the Parks Manager.
- **4.20.** No person shall deposit on the ground any lighted match, cigar, cigarette or other burning substance within the limits of any park, trail or beach.
- **4.21.** No person shall create a nuisance or disturbance in any park or other public place by:
  - (a) Participating in a fight or physical confrontation between consenting or non-consenting

adults.

- (b) Urinating or leaving any human waste other than in a public washroom.
- (c) Swearing, shouting, screaming or yelling.
- (d) Using vulgar, indecent, grossly insulting or obscene language.
- (e) Using threatening or abusive words or behaviour.
- (f) Panhandling or loitering.
- (g) Without lawful justification, obstructing the free use and enjoyment of the park or other public place by another person.
- (h) Behaving in a disorderly or offensive manner.
- **4.22.** No person without written permission from the Parks Manager shall produce any concert, musical show, band show, circus, exhibition and opera, or theatrical production, voice, use an amplification device, broadcasting or make other noise that disturbs or tends to disturb the free use and enjoyment of any park or any beach by any other person.
- **4.23.** No person shall molest, disturb, frighten, injure, catch, trap or snare any bird or animal in any park, trail or beach.
- **4.24.** No person shall suffer or permit an animal owned, housed, or harboured by him/her or in his/her charge to be in any park, trail or beach except in accordance with the City of Langford **Animal Control Bylaw**, or any successor bylaw.
- **4.25.** Notwithstanding any provision in the Bylaw, nothing shall interfere with any rights of any person with a disability that requires the use of a certified assistance or guide dog as set out in the **Guide Animal Act R.S.B.C 1996 c. 177.**
- **4.26.** No person, except persons with a Police Dog, shall allow or permit a dog in their care or control to be in or on a playground facility or public beach, unless the dog is leashed as defined in the City of Langford **Animal Control Bylaw.**
- **4.27.** No person, except persons with a Guide Dog or Police Dog, shall allow or permit a dog in their care or control to be in or on a sports field at any time.
- **4.28.** No person shall smoke or vape cannabis on or in a park, beach, open space or trail.
- **4.29.** The prohibition in subsection 4.28 of this Bylaw does not apply to:
  - (a) the smoking of tobacco inside a private vehicle; or
  - (b) the ceremonial use of tobacco as part of a traditional aboriginal cultural activity.
- **4.30.** Every person within a Park, Trail, or Beach shall obey all Federal and Provincial enactments and City bylaws including, without limitation, all Posted Notices.

#### 5. Park Permits

- **5.1.** Any person wishing to use a park for an organized event must apply to the City for a Park Permit. They must also provide written proof of 5 million dollars liability insurance to the City.
- **5.2.** Any person issued a park permit to hold an event in a municipal Park must be responsible for cleaning up the Park after the event. (Schedule B)

#### 6. Enforcement

**6.1.** The Municipal Bylaw Enforcement Officer or a Royal Canadian Mounted Police Officer is hereby authorized to enforce this bylaw.

- **6.2.** Municipal Bylaw Enforcement Officer or a Royal Canadian Mounted Police Officer may issue, in writing, such notices or orders as may be necessary to inform a park user where a contravention of this bylaw has been observed.
- **6.3.** The Municipal Bylaw Enforcement Officer or a Royal Canadian Mounted Police Officer may order a person who contravenes this bylaw to comply within the period specified.
- **6.4.** The Parks Manager, a Royal Canadian Mounted Police Officer or a Municipal Bylaw Enforcement Officer may remove, seize and impound or cause the removal, seizure or impoundment of any chattel placed or left in any park, open space, trail or beach contrary to this bylaw.
- 6.5. After the removal, seizure or impoundment of a chattel under subsection 6.4, the chattel shall be made available to be claimed in accordance with subsection 6.6 by a person entitled to its possession by no later than 2:00 p.m. on the next business day following the date of its removal, seizure or impoundment.
- A person entitled to possession of a chattel removed, seized or impounded under this bylaw may reclaim the chattel by contacting the City's Parks Department during regular business hours and paying the City a fee equal to the sum of the fees that would have been payable to the City under subsection 7.3.1 of Traffic Bylaw No. 33, 1995 if the chattel had been removed, detained or impounded under Traffic Bylaw No. 33, 1995.
- 6.7. If a person entitled to possession of a chattel has not claimed it under section 6.6 within 30 days following its impoundment, the Parks Manager may:
  - (a) cause the chattel to be sold, by public auction, to the highest bidder; or
  - (b) cause the chattel to be disposed of as garbage if it appears to the Parks Manager that the chattel or structure has no market value.
- **6.8.** Where a chattel is sold at public auction under subsection 6.7(a), the proceeds of the sale shall be applied as follows:
  - (a) firstly, to pay the costs incurred by the City for the removal, storage and auctioning of the chattel; and
  - (b) secondly, to pay the remainder, if any, to the person who owned the chattel if that person's identity and location are known.
- 6.9. Where an amount referred to subsection 6.8(b) remains unclaimed and the identity or location of the person entitled to it is unknown after one year following the date of the auction, the amount shall be paid into the general revenue of the City.
- **6.10.** Despite any other provision of this bylaw, the Parks Manager or a Municipal Bylaw Enforcement Officer may immediately remove and dispose of as garbage any of the following items placed or found in or on a park, open space, trail, beach or other public place:
  - (a) any refuse, garbage, noxious or offensive matter or substance;
  - (b) a chattel or other thing that has been abandoned if it the chattel or other thing has no apparent market value.

#### 7. Offence

- **7.1.** No person shall do any act or suffer or permit any act or thing to be done in contravention of this bylaw.
- **7.2.** Every person who contravenes this bylaw commits an offence and is liable, on summary conviction, to a fine of not more than \$10,000.
- **7.3.** Each day during which a contravention of this bylaw occurs or continues shall be deemed a separate offence
- **7.4.** Any person who commits a second or subsequent offence under this bylaw is liable to an increased fine as set out in the District of Langford Ticket Information Authorization Bylaw, 1993.
- 8. This Bylaw shall be cited for all purposes as "Langford Municipal Park Regulation Bylaw No. 177, 1996".
